



Foster Drinking Water Cooler Cleaning Instructions

External cleaning

The curved tap and water dribbler should be cleaned daily or more frequently if desired using a suitable sanitiser.

The exterior of the machine should be cleaned weekly or more frequently if desired using a suitable sanitiser.

Internal Hygienic Cleaning.

This operation should be performed by a qualified technician.

WARNING!

Considering that the product used for the hygienic cleaning are acid and alkali corrosive substances, disposable gloves must be used as well as glasses to protect your eyes.

The cleaning must be carried out when:

- Parts of the water system have been changed.
- Contamination has taken place or you think it may have.
- The appliance has been re-installed.

Items required:

Water pump. Two lengths of hose. Bucket big enough to contain 5 litres of water. Suitable hygienic cleaner.

If the appliance is fitted with a chlorine filter remove the filter and fit in its place a false cartridge or bypass it and connect directly on to the water inlet.

Fill the bucket with 5 litres of clean tap water. Pour sufficient of the hygienic cleaner as per the manufacturers instructions. Do not exceed the stated dose.

- Connect the pipes to the pump and to the appliance as per the detail below.
- Start the pump allowing the solution to enter the water circuit, at the same time open the water outlet taps and allow the solution to pass through the circuit.
- Before the solution is all used turn off the pump and the water outlet taps.
- Leave the solution in the water circuit for 20 minutes.
- Disconnect the pump from the appliance and reconnect it to the mains supply.
- Run at least 15 litres of water through the water system before tasting the water, if the water has a bitter taste continue the flushing process until the bitterness clears.
